Item No. 59.05

To consider the recommendations of the Chairman, SUGC.

Resolution

Following recommendations / decision of the Chairman, SUGC were put up before the Senate by the Chairman, SUGC for consideration on the case to case basis.

(i), (ii) & (iii)

The Agenda Item numbers 59.05 (i), (ii) and (iii) are action taken report of Department of Applied Mechanics, Department of Electrical Engineering and Department of Civil Engineering, pursuant to Resolution no 1 of the Standing Committee meeting dated 23.06.2017 duly approved by the Senate. These shall be sent and circulated vide letter No. 553/Acad./2017-18, dated 01.08.2017 to the office of the Dean (Academic) for further necessary action.

(iv), (v), (vi) & (vii)

"Regarding Agenda Item numbers 59.05 (iv), (v), (vi) and (vii), the Senate resolved that all these matters shall be referred back to the departments in order to review the same in view of the student's intake, placement, and comments/ observations of NBA reports. The revised recommendations shall be taken up in the next meeting of the Senate.

(viii)

The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the minutes of DUGC, CED, dated 22/09/2017 and 06/10/2017 regarding the retention of the approved courses with course codes CE-1302, and course title "Computer based Numerical techniques" and the course code CE-1352 with title "Computer based Numerical techniques (Lab)" should run as such in the current semester and onwards as DUGC, CED found mistake in the titles of these two courses running in the previous semesters with course code and titles as: CE-1302 (Numerical Techiniques and Applications) and CE-1352 (Numerical Techiniques and Applications). The Senate resolved that the course code and titles CE-1302 (Numerical Techiniques and Applications) and CE-1352 (Numerical Techiniques and Applications) running since academic session 2013-14 need not be changed as the course contents of the two are exactly same.

The Senate also considered recommendations of the Chairman, SUGC on the request of following students of B.Tech. programme on the case to case basis. The Senate resolved as below:

- (ix) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Shyam Datt (Reg. No. 20109028) dated 09/10/2017 for permission to allow him two parallel courses in the current semester was considered by the Senate. The advice of Chairman, SUGC that the department should counsel the student having low academic records, be advised to drop these additional courses and may concentrate on the semester courses running at present. The student has been granted an extension of one year as a special case from the Odd Semester of academic session 2017-18. The Senate advised communicating the decision of SUGC to the concerned department.
- The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Amresh Yadav (Reg. No.20155014), of department of Electronics and Communication Engineering Department for semester leave for previous semester (Jan.- June, 2017) on sympathetic ground due to sudden demise of his father was considered by the Senate and resolved to grant the semester leave for previous semester (Jan. June, 2017).

- (xi) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Swetang Singh (Reg. No. 20163140) dated 21/09/2017 regarding semester leave on the ground of flooding of his hometown was considered by Senate. The Senate resolved to grant the semester leave for Odd Semester of Session 2017-18.
- (xii) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Pradeep Behra (Reg. No. 20112018) of the Department of EED was discussed by the Senate for counting of his attendance from the date of late registration, i.e., 28/07/2017 in the current semester because of the wrong grade reflected in his transcript. The Senate advised to follow the clause no. 9.1 of the Ordinances of Bachelor Programme.
- (xiii) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Ms. Garima Katiyar (Reg. No. 20171034) of Department of Civil Engineering for granting leave of 23 days, i.e., from 19/08/2017 to 10/09/2017, due to medical reasons, was considered by the Senate. However, a minimum of 75% attendance is necessary to be maintained as per clause no. 9.1 of the Ordinances of Bachelor Programme. No waiver for the leave days will be granted in calculating the overall attendance. The Senate noted the same.
- (xiv) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Anubav Potade (Reg. No. 20161026) requesting leave for three weeks (20 days), w.e.f., 17/07/2017 to 05/08/2017, due to jaundice problem was considered by Senate. However, a minimum of 75% attendance is necessary to be maintained as per clause no. 9.1 of the Ordinances of Bachelor Programme. No waiver for the leave days will be granted in calculating the overall attendance. The Senate noted the same.
- (xv) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Abhinav Kumar Giri (20174045), a student of CSED, for providing special care and assistance in the examination of Engineering Graphics and to give a scribe in the examination of Engineering Graphics was considered by the Senate. The Senate accepted the same, except re-examination of his eyes by the medical board as the candidate has provided a certificate from Chief Medical Officer and Institute's Medical Board has examined him before admission.
- (xvi) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on merging the Production & Industrial Engineering programme with the Mechanical Engineering programme was discussed by the Senate. The Senate resolution on this matter is already covered under agenda Item No. 59.03.
- (xvii) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Santosh Abhinav Koppula (Reg. No. 20169029) dated 14/09/2017 regarding the conduct of Mid- Semester of Examination was considered by the Senate. The student has submitted the BP-03 form in time, but due to an error in the course code (wrongly filled code as CY-1201 in place of CY-1101), it could not be rectified in time by the department, and the corrected BP-03 form was resubmitted on 14/09/2017. SUGC discussed conducting mid-semester examination for the student. Since there is no provision for re-examination in the Ordinances for Bachelor Programme, the matter was turned down by the Senate.

(xviii) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Ravi Ranjan Kumar (20106057) for granting permission to take Mid-Semester Examination on the sympathetic ground and one-year extension to the programme was considered by the Senate. Since there is no provision for re-examination in the Ordinances for Bachelor Programme, the matter was turned down by the Senate.

(xix) The recommendation of Chairman, SUGC on the request of Mr. Yaddnapudi K. Kumar (Reg. No. 20165085) dated 18/09/2017 about the conduct of his Mid- Semester Examination on the ground of his mother's demise, was discussed by the Senate. Since there is no provision for re-examination in the Ordinances for Bachelor Programme, the matter was turned down by the Senate.

Item No. 59.06

To consider the recommendations of the Chairman, SMPC.

Resolution

- The recommendations of the Chairman, SMPC on the request of following students of Masters' programme were put up before the Senate by the Chairman, SMPC for consideration on the case to case basis:
- (i) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding semester leave of Mr. Ram Krishna Gupta [2016BM12] as he got selected in BSNL. The Senate resolved to allow him for grant of one Semester leave (for Odd Semester of academic session 2017-18). However, the candidate has to produce 'No Objection Certificate' from his employer and fulfill the residency requirement for the programme as per Ordinances.
- (ii) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding semester leave of Mr. Rajeev Kumar (2016GI11) as he got selected in RVNL. The Senate resolved to allow him for grant of one Semester leave (for Odd Semester of academic session 2017-18). However, the candidate has to produce 'No Objection Certificate' from his employer and fulfill the residency requirement for the programme as per Ordinances.
- (iii) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding semester leave of Mr. Sachin Kumar (Reg. No. 2016TR03) as he got selected in RVNL. The Senate resolved to allow him for grant of one Semester leave (for Odd Semester of academic session 2017-18). However, the candidate has to produce 'No Objection Certificate' from his employer and fulfill the residency requirement for the programme as per Ordinances.
- (iv) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding Semester leave of Mr. Rohindra Murmu (2016CA63), a student of Master of Computer Applications, due to illness. The Senate resolved to allow him for grant of one Semester leave (for Odd Semester of academic session 2017-18).
- The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding mercy (v) appeal of Mr. Rohit Kumar Chandra (Reg. No. 2016AM07) who had a CPI of 5.6 after first Semester and CPI of 5.3 after second Semester (post supplementary examination). He is having no E/F grade in any subject. As per Masters' Programme Ordinance Clause 9, Mr. Rohit Kumar Chandra cannot continue in the programme as his CPI after the second Semester (post supplementary examination) is less than 5.5. Senate resolved to allow him to remove the academic deficiency of his second semester either by taking the

subjects during Even Semester (2017-18) or by appearing in the supplementary examination 2018, in order to become eligible for registration in the third semester.

- (vi) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding the change of name of the current M. Tech. Programme (M. Tech. GIS & Remote Sensing) to M. Tech in Geoinformatics. The existing PG programme course curriculum will remain unchanged till the next Board of Academics meeting. Senate resolved to accept the same.
- (vii) The Senate considered the recommendations of DMPC of Civil Engineering Department dated 04.09.2017 regarding transfer and running of M. Tech. Course in GIS Cell with specialization in GIS & Remote Sensing to Civil Engineering Department. In this context, the DMPC of GIS Cell gave the recommendation dated 23.10.2017 to run the course within the GIS Cell itself. Senate resolved to accept the recommendation of DMPC of GIS Cell, and at the same time Senate turned down the recommendation of DMPC of Civil Engineering Department.
- (viii) The Senate considered the recommendations of DMPC of Mechanical Engineering Department dated 04.09.2017 regarding revision of M.Tech. Programme. The matter is already discussed under agenda item no 59.03. of the minutes of the 59th Senate meeting.
 - (ix) The Senate considered the recommendations of SMPC regarding revised course structure and syllabus for M.Sc. "Mathematics and scientific computing." The Senate resolved to circulate the revised course structure and syllabus for M.Sc. "Mathematics and Scientific computing" to all the Senate members for deliberations in future.


