- 3. All the applicants will submit their bio-data, present status of their research work duly recommended by the Supervisor, a copy of the Registration certificate, a synopsis/note on their research work along with their applications. The academic career of the candidate, as well as the recommendations of the supervisors in regard to their competence and motivation should be given due edge.
- 4. Scholars will be selected from the neighboring states/catchments area of the course organizing institute.
- 5. The scholars will be selected mainly from **SC/ST category**. Subject to vacancies, students from socially deprived sections should be given preference.

Selection of Participants:

Selection of participants will be based on their bio-data, present status of their research work duly recommended by the Supervisor, a copy of the Registration certificate, a synopsis/note on their research work along with their applications. Only 40 participants will be considered for attending the programme.

Registration Fee:

There will be no registration fee for the participants.

Travel Allowances and Accommodation:

Non-local participants will be entitled to get sleeper class return railway fares/actual Bus fare from the shortest distance and free of cost food and lodging facilities will be provided to outstation participants.
