Simultaneously, the conference will host the 11<sup>th</sup> Professor Sukumar Maiti Polymer Award Foundation Function. Prof. Sukumar Maiti is a renowned polymer scientist who started his career in Petrochemical Industry in late nineteen sixties and left the lucrative job of industry to join academia at IIT Kharagpur at the age of 32 as full professor, just to train the young mind for betterment of science and engineering. His students formed a Foundation by his name to accelerate his benevolent ideas. The Professor Sukumar Maiti Polymer Award Foundation, this year will celebrate the eleventh polymer award function at Allahabad. The Conference also aims to encourage the young

researchers who will participate in it by providing best paper presentation awards.
