- It has been observed that large number of students have tendency of not doing the physical registration on 4. due dates at the beginning of odd and even semesters and later on report for late registration. The committee took the cognizance of the issue and in order to discourage the same, it recommends the following:
  - (I) Late registration should not be permitted without prior permission from Dean (Academic)/Chairman, Senate and it should be permitted for genuine reasons only.
  - (ii) Students allowed for late registration need to pay the late registration fee of Rs. 2500/- during the permitted duration of late registration (as per academic calendar). Beyond this if any student is permitted, he/she needs to pay fine of Rs. 500/- per day in addition to Rs. 2500/- late fee.
  - (III) Students who do not pay the institute fee till due date (last date of online registration as per academic calendar) will be required to pay the late fee payment charge of Rs. 2500/- till notified date of late registration in addition to late fee/late fine mentloned in point (ii) above.
  - (iv) No registration should be allowed beyond the due date for late registration without permission of Chairman Senate/Director.

# Guidelines for Institute Faculty for Supervising / Co-supervising students of other Institute / University

- 1. In the Guidelines, unless the context otherwise requires,
  - (a) "Institute" means Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad (MNNIT Allahabad).
  - (b) "Parent Institute / University" means the Institute in which the Research Scholar is enrolled for the degree program.
  - (c) "Supervisor / Co-supervisor" means Regular Faculty of MNNIT Allahabad.
  - (d) "Research Scholars" means Research Scholars having enrollment in other Institute / University.
- The Faculty of MNNIT Allahabad who wish to Supervise / Co-supervise students of other Institute / University shall abide the following:
  - (a) Supervisor / Co-Supervisor shall not Supervise/Co-supervise more than two Research Scholars. Preferably, these two Research Scholars shall be from different Parent Institute/University.
  - (b) The Research Scholar need to be stationed and/or working within Allahabad Development Authority (ADA) jurisdiction.
  - (c) The Research Scholar need to be enrolled in any of the following category of Institutions.
    - Category I Institutions:
      - > IITs / NITs / IISc / IISERs / IIMs / IIITs/IIEST Shibpur.
    - Category II Institutions:
      - > Other Centrally funded Technical Institutions.
      - > State funded Technical Institutions.
    - Category III Institutions: Any other Institutions appearing within top 100 rank of NIRF ranking published by MHRD in last two years.

- (d) The Research Scholar shall submit Rs. 10,000/- per semester in Institute as supervision fee in lieu of facilitating the Institute faculty as his/ her Supervisor/Co-supervisor. This fee will include fee for utilisation of research facilities such as labs, library, Software's etc. to the Research Scholars on Saturdays only.
- (e) Charges mentioned at point No. 2(d) would be raised by 20% every two year.
- (f) Supervisor / Co-supervisor shall preferably facilitate the Research Scholar on Saturdays.
- (g) The registration record of these Research Scholars would be maintained at the Office of Dean(Academic) and concerned departments.
- (h) Supervisor/Co-supervisor would be entitled for all the IPR points generated through this activity.
- (i) In case of Research Scholar belonging to a foreign university then a separate MoU need to be signed with the said university.

In case the Supervisor / Co-Supervisor is required to travel to Parent Institute, then that shall be considered under Special Casual leave. The Institute shall not borne any expense incurred by the Supervisor / Co-Supervisor in this regard.

All the departments/cell/school have provided inputs which are compiled and attached as ANNEXURE-1 with this minutes.

The office of the Dean (Academic) has sent a reminder letter to those Departments who had not provided their inputs on the Examination Reforms as per the recommendation of AICTE vide letter No. 1224/Acad./2018-19 dated March 28, 2019 to provide their inputs on the same.

Based on the inputs received from different departments following are the resolutions / recommendations of the Committee:

The MHRD has suggested implementing the examination reforms proposed by AICTE from A.Y. 2018-19. These examination reforms will ensure the outcome based learning and development of higher-order abilities and professional skills in the students. The reforms suggest the assessment strategies for an outcome-based education system. It provides the possible ways to improve the structure and quality of assessments by the inclusion of higher-order abilities and professional skills' assessment. After going through the inputs received from different departments and deliberations, the committee feels that the Institute is already following certain parts of the proposed reforms and supports in-principle to implement the remaining examination reforms in the future. The specific observations of the committee are as follows:

1. The members observed that the programme outcomes (POs) have already been clearly defined for our UG/PG programmes and mapped to various graduate attributes like basic knowledge, problem analysis, investigation of complex problems, modern tools usage, ethics that helps in outcome-based assessment. The assessment of higher order abilities and professional skills is

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- following Bloom's taxonomy to a larger extent. Departments assess, students through assignment, quizes, fixed hour examinations as well as through course projects, mini/minor projects, internship experience, and final year projects.
- The Course outcomes for different courses may be different; thus their best or appropriate evaluation method may be different. It requires a flexible curriculum structure, with the provision of the different component of marks for different subjects where the TA (20 to 40 marks) and examination (80 to 60 marks) components may be varied within a range and can be notified by the course coordinator at the beginning of the semester. It also requires a decentralized evaluation (examination) system with flexible grading (mark splitting) scheme.
- The committee believes that a faculty member needs to put more effort into designing the question paper and evaluation of different components for individual students besides maintaining huge records for the same, In order to do that individual faculty should not be given more than one course per semester (Eilher PG or UG course only). The assessment also demands more time per student, which requires the reduction in the existing class size and better infrastructure. The current student-teacher ratio and presently available infrastructure at our institute do not support the exact implementation of the suggested reforms in one step rather the same can be done gradually in multiple steps.
- The academic 'Credit' points for Project work in the B.Tech. final year should be increased in order to encourage project-based learning. The number of theory courses in UG/PG courses and the total credit points required for the award of the degree should be reduced so that the students will be able to devote more time in developing the higher-order abilities and professional skills.
- The quality of question papers should be monitored as per the guidelines given in the documents by constituting a committee at the department level and one committee at the institute level. A workshop by experts from institutes like NITTR may be planned for proper training of faculty members on the proposed examination reforms.
- The committee also felt that in the upcoming end semester examinations, the course coordinator might be asked to send a copy of the syllabus taught (along with COs and other details) to the examination cell. This copy of syllabus may be packed in the EXTRA PAPERS envelope containing five question papers.
