Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad (MNNIT) is an Institute with total commitment to quality and excellence in academic pursuits. It was established in 1961 as a joint enterprise of Government of India and Government of UP. The Institute had begun with offering Bachelor Degree Programmes in Civil, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering. The first Master's Programme of the Institute was introduced by the Mechanical Engineering Department in the year 1966. In the year 2002, it was declared National Institute of Technology and an institute of national importance by MHRD, Govt. Of India. The Institute now offers nine B.Tech., nineteen M.Tech.
