Preamble

The inherent value of research is established if it incorporates in its design, the potential to percolate deep down for the cause and benefit not only to academia but also society and humanity at large. The process of scientific research is useful if it sees the dawn of publication. The daunting challenge of getting an academic paper published weighs on mentoring and knowing a systematic approach of carving out the right piece of knowledge which interests the readers and complies with the journal standards. The 'Author Development Workshop' is an attempt to address the issues related to writing and communicating research papers.

Conducting quality research and documenting the same into a form which may be accepted for publication, are entirely two separate issues. Publication of a research work post its completion is an essential criterion for the recognition of both the researcher and the research work. The workshop aims to train the participants about the systematic process involved in converting a particular research work into a publishable manuscript, which can be communicated to a reputed journal for publication. It focuses mainly on the different issues and challenges involved in writing various sections of the paper, such as Abstract, Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, Discussion of Results, and Conclusion part. It also deals with issues of commutating the manuscript to a Journal and handling the reviewer's comment. The workshop would be useful for the professional development of faculties, trainers, researchers, and professionals.

Objective of Workshop

- 1. To understand the process of systematic literature review, theory development and formulation of research hypotheses
- 2. To familiarize the participants with the general structure and elements of a research article and deal with the issues and challenges of preparing and writing a research manuscript suitable for publication.
- 3. To understand the review process and to accommodate reviewers perspective leading to successful publication

Course Content

General structure and elements of research article, writing abstract, writing introduction, reviewing of scholarly articles, conducting systematic literature review, writing literature review, what constitutes theoretical contribution, development of conceptual model and hypotheses, theory building, writing methodology, qualitative research, Interpretive Structural Modelling (ISM), reporting and discussion of results and research contributions, writing conclusions, writing and communicating research paper, general submission and revision related issues, how to write a review?, presentations from interested participants (selected in advance)

Pedagogy

Practical examples, group discussions, conceptual lectures, and experience sharing are some of the techniques that would be employed in the workshop. The participants would be expected to actively participate in class discussions.

Prof. Yogesh K. Dwivedi

Professor Yogesh K. Dwivedi is a Professor at the School of Management, Swansea University, United Kingdom. His research interests are in the area of Information Systems (IS) including the adoption and diffusion of emerging ICTs (e.g., broadband, RFID, e-commerce, e-government, m-commerce, m-payments, m-government); an interest in analysis of usage trends of IS theories and research



approaches; and understanding the evolution of IS, e-government and e-commerce research. His work on these topics has been published in a range of leading academic journals, including Communications of the ACM, European Journal of Information Systems, International Journal of Production Research, and Journal of the Operational Research Society. He has presented his research at key international conferences in Asia, Australasia, Europe, and North America. He has co-edited more than ten books on technology adoption, e-government, and IS theory and had them published by international publishers such as Springer, Routledge, and Emerald. He acted as co-editor of fourteen special issues; organized tracks, mini-tracks, and panels in leading conferences; and served as programme co-chair of IFIP WG 8.6 Conference at the prestigious IIM Bangalore, India in 2013. He is secretary of IFIP 8.6 Working Group, a member of the AIM Scholar Pool, a life member of IFIP 8 WG 8.5, 8.6, and an annual member of the Association of Information Systems.

Prof. R. R. K. Sharma

Professor R. R. K. Sharma is currently Professor (HAG Scale) in the Department of Industrial and Management Engineering (IME), IIT Kanpur. He has been Sanjay Mittal Chair Professor at IIT Kanpur from 2015-2018. Dr. Sharma has had 33 years of career to date. Started as a graduate engineer trainee with TELCO (PUNE) (now TATA MOTORS INDIA) during 1980-82 and later went on to do a Ph.D. in management

at I.I.M., Ahmedabad. After Ph. D. in management, he worked with TVS Suzuki (for nine months) as an executive assistant to GM (marketing). Now he has 30 years of teaching and research experience at the Department of Industrial and Management Engineering, I.I.T., Kanpur.
