

(b) The Senate confirmed and ratified the approval accorded by the Chairman, Senate on the recommendations made by the Standing Committee on Urgent Academic Matters in its meetings held on 15.04.2021 & 14.05.2021. The evaluation scheme for B.Tech. Final Year as approved by the Chairman, Senate is reproduced below:

"The End Semester Theory Examination for Final Year B. Tech. students will be conducted as Viva-Voce Examination. The Evaluation will be of 60 marks and will be having following components-

- (a) 30 Marks for Viva Voce Examination
- (b) 30 Marks will be based on Max (Previous CPI, Previous Semester SPI) of the student.

Rest 40 marks will be evaluated based on internal assessment as done earlier. The Practical examination conduction and evaluation are to be done as earlier".

Item No. 71.04

To discuss the progress of implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) – 2020 in the Institute.

Resolution

The Senate considered the proposal of Dean (Academic) on credit transfer and adoption of MOOCs courses as a part of the NEP-2020.

The Senate after deliberations resolved to accept the guidelines of SWAYAM [Ref. UGC (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses through SWAYAM Regulation, 2016, New Delhi, the 19th July, 2016) in principle with a 20% ceiling on maximum number of courses a student can opt as MOOCs courses.

The Senate also resolved to float a minimum of 5 MOOCs courses as open elective for final year curriculum in the academic year 2021-22 having at least 02 credits. These courses will be floated by the different academic departments of the Institute.

Item No. 71.05

To consider nomination of Senate nominees to the Board of Governors of the Institute, as its members.

Resolution

The Senate considered the nomination of Senate members to the Board of Governors of the Institute as its members in terms of the guidelines accepted by the Senate for nomination of two members vide resolution No. 70.07 (ii) of the Seventieth (70th) meeting of the Senate held on March 23, 2021.

The Senate, in consideration of the above, resolved to nominate one Professor and One Associate Professor of the Institute in order of seniority to act as members of the Board of Governors as nominee of the Senate, in terms of Section 11 (f) of the NITSER Act-2007.

Accordingly, the Senate resolved to nominate following faculty members as nominees of the Senate to the Board of Governors, next in the order of seniority to existing/previous members in respective cadres.

Resolution

(i) The Senate considered the recommendations made by the Standing Committee on Urgent Academic Matters in its meeting held on 26.05.2021 regarding the admission criteria for ICCR sponsored candidates in B.Tech., M.Tech. and Ph.D. programmes for the academic year 2021-22.

The Senate, after detailed deliberations, resolved to accept the same with modification that there will not be any limit on the age of the candidates for

admission to B.Tech. Programmes as it is not required as per the Institute ordinances/admission criteria of CSAB.

A copy of the approved minutes dated 26.05.2021 of the Standing Committee on urgent Academic Matters is placed at **ANNEXURE-II**.

- (ii) The Senate considered the recommendations made by the Standing Committee on Urgent Academic Matters in its meeting held on 26.05.2021 regarding the modalities of Ph.D. Supervisor allotment and accepted the same. The Senate after detailed deliberations, resolved that these recommendations will serve as broad guidelines for the departments to prepare and implement the roster for allotment of Ph.D. Supervisors. Further, in case of any deviation, beyond the approved guidelines, the same may be referred to Chairman, Senate through Chairman, SDPC and Dean (Academic) for consideration and final decision.
- (iii) The Senate considered and resolved to accept the modified Academic Calendar proposed by Dean (Academic). The Senate also authorised the Chairman, Senate to approve the subsequent changes in calendar in future, if needed. The Senate also accepted the same evaluation scheme [adopted for final year B.Tech. students as per resolution 71.03(b)] for End Semester Examination of B.Tech. 4th & 6th Sem., M.Tech. 2nd & 4th Sem., MBA 2nd & 4th Sem., M.Sc. 2nd & 4th Sem., and MCA 1st & 4th Sem. and Ph.D. (Course Work) along with back paper.

The Senate also accepted to adopt the following scheme for End Semester Theory Examination of MCA first semester:

The Evaluation of 60 marks will be having following components-

- (a) 30 Marks for Viva Voce Examination.
- (b) 30 Marks for Quiz based Examination or assignment of practical nature.



Rest 40 marks will be evaluated based on internal assessment as per the established practices. The Practical Examination conduction and evaluation are to be carried out as done earlier.

(iv) The Senate considered the proposal of the Head, Department of Applied Mechanics for start of two UG programmes based on NEP-2020. The Senate observed that the proposal has not been routed through DUGC and SUGC.

The Senate considering the above, resolved that the matter should be routed through the DUGC and SUGC for further consideration.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks to the Chair.



#### Agenda Item 1

To finalize the Ph.D. admission criteria for admission in academic session 2021-22.

#### Resolution

- 1. In the light of the present COVID-19 situation, the committee decided that it is not reasonable to call the candidates for the written examination for admissions in PhD, M.Tech. (Part-time and Sponsored) and MBA (Part-time) programsas per the earlier advertised scheme [Annexure I], and a hybrid scheme with online interview of the candidates seems to be a feasible solution for the safety issues.
- 2. In view of this, the committee resolved that the rank list of the candidates for admissions in Ph.D. programsin academic session 2021-22 will be prepared on the basis of the marking scheme as given in Annexure II.
- 3. The committee also resolved that the rank list of the candidates for admissions in M.Tech. (Part-time and Sponsored) and MBA (Part-time) programsin academic session 2021-22will be prepared on the basis of the marking scheme as given in Annexure III.
- 4. For the PhD candidates under categories 11, 12, 13 and 15, the total marks obtained for UG/PG/GATE/NET/Publications (out of 65 marks) alone will be used for shortlisting the candidates for online interview.
- 5. For the PhD candidates under categories 11 and 12, the total marks obtained for UG/PG/GATE/NET/Publications (out of 65 marks) added to the online interview (out of 35 marks) will be used for preparing the merit list of the candidates (total marks out of 100).
- 6. For the PhD candidates under categories 13, 14 and 15, the marks obtained in online interview alone (out of 100 marks) will be used for preparing the merit list of the candidates.
- 7. The candidates under category 15 shall also be evaluated on the basis of Recommendation of their employer and a Statement of Purpose during online interview.
- 8. The candidates under categories 14 and 15 must submit a No Objection Certificate from employer at the time of interview.

#### 2. Eligibility criteria

- (a) The eligibility criteria for admission in B.Tech, programmes will be as per the Minutes of the Senate Standing Committee, dated 2/6/2020:
  - The candidate should have minimum 75% aggregate or 8.0/10.0 CGPA with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English in XIII or equivalent examination,
  - The candidate must have valid SAT (subject) score.
  - The age of the candidate should be below or equal to 25 years as on October 1st of the admission year, i.e. if candidate is applying for admission in ecademic session 2021-2022, the date of birth of the candidate should be on or after October 01, 1996.
  - The year of appearing in qualifying examination should be the year of admission and previous two years, i.e. if candidate is applying for admission in academic session 2021-2022, then the year of appearing in qualifying examination shall be 2021, 2020 and 2019.
- (b) Additionally, the committee recommended that for admission in B.Tech. programmes, the candidate must have valid SAT (subject tests) score in Mathematics, English and Physics/Chemistry for academic Session 2021-22. Further, from academic Session 2022-23, the candidate must have valid JEE (main) score in place of valid SAT (subject) score.
- (c) The eligibility criteria for admission in M.Tech, programmes will be as per the Minutes of the Senate Standing Committee, dated 2/6/2020;
  - The candidate must have valid GRE score in addition to other qualifying degree requirements as per the Ordinances of Masters' programme.
- (d) The eligibility criteria for admission in PhD programmes will be as per the Minutes of the Senate Standing Committee, dated 2/6/2020;
  - The candidate must have valid GRE score in addition to other qualifying degree requirements for admission to PhD programmes of any department as per the Ordinances of Doctoral programme.



(f) If multiple students in any category (e.g. 11, 12, 13, and 15) give a particular faculty name as the first choice for supervisor allotment, the particular faculty member shall be allotted to the student who is having the highest ranking the respective category.

(g) If multiple students give a particular faculty name as the first choice for supervisor allotment and if these students are having the same marit (e.g., first rank in General/OBC/SC/..., categories), the particular faculty member shall be allotted to the student who is having the highest rank in General category rank list. In case, there are more than one students having common ment, the particular faculty shall be allotted to the eldest student amongst those.

(h) The students will be permitted to join with only one supervisor at the time of the approval from the Chairman, SDPC and the concerned faculty names will be marked as "alioited", and therefore their names will appear in the list-3 [Point a (iii)] in next academic year.

(f) The faculty on levels 10 and 11 (if contractual) will be allotted the students in Joint supervision along with a regular faculty of the department being the second supervisor. The second supervisor will be decided by the Head of the department in consultation with the contractual faculty and the proposed regular faculty.

(i) A list of the eligible supervisors will be kept with Chairman SDPC and if any recommendation is not in line with the guidelines mentioned above, it will NOT be approved in DP-12(b) form and the department will have to get another supervisor for the student. The roster will be maintained at the office of SOPC in the office of Dean (Academic) and at the department.

(k) The method of the allotment of the supervisor will be the same in all categories, except for category 14 meant for faculty/staft/sponsored project fellow of MNNIT. Project fellow shall be registered under the PI(s)/Co-PI(s) in the same department where the project has been sanctioned. For faculty and staff, the supervisor will be selected in consultation with the Head of the department.

If any faculty member is having number of vacancies lesser than the number
of students he/she is eligible to take as per the proposed roster scheme, the
faculty member shall be given the choice to select the student(s) from

(m) Any case that is beyond the guidelines mentioned above shall be handled as per the Ordinances for Doctoral programme and Senate resolutions. Further, such cases may be referred to the Senate through proper channel for further decision, as and when warranted.

As per the recommendation of Standing Committee further approval by Chairman Senate the End Semester Examination for Final Year B. Tech. students, is under progress as per the modified evaluation scheme for End Semester Examination. The evaluation scheme has been adopted due to COVID situation across the country. As the situation of COVID across the country is still persisting, it is therefore, proposed to adopt the same evaluation scheme (approved for final year) for all other students for their End Semester Examination (Even Sem.) 2020-21.

Further, I would like to highlight that End Semester Examination of MCA First Semester students is also due and the examination scheme approved for final year cannot be implemented on them, as they do not have desired academic performance indices (Previous CPI, Previous Semester SPI). In view of this, it is proposed to adopt the following scheme for End Semester Theory Examination of MCA first semester:

#### Scheme 1

The Evaluation of 60 marks will be having following components-

- a) 30 Marks for Viva Voce Examination
- (b) 30 Marks for Quiz based Examination or assignment of practical nature.

Rest 40 marks will be evaluated based on Internal assessment as per the established practices. The Practical Examination conduction and evaluation are to be carried out as done earlier.
