Institute Profile



- MNNIT Allahabad formerly known as Motilal Nehru Regional Engineering College (MNREC) Allahabad.
- Came into existence in 1961.
- Foundation laid by Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru in 1961.
- Building inaugurated by Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri in 1965.
- Spread over 222 acres.

Institute Profile



- MNREC started as a joint enterprise of the Government of India and the Government of Uttar Pradesh.
- MNREC was affiliated to the:
 - University of Allahabad as its Faculty of Engineering, until 2000.
 - U.P. Technical University during 2000-2002.
- In 2002, MNREC was converted to National Institute of Technology and was fully funded by the Government of India.
- In 2007, the Institute was granted the status of Institution of National Importance by an Act of Parliament.

Institute Profile



- In 1972, MNREC initiated a self-employment project and established an Industrial Estate with 68 sheds.
- The Institute received assistance from UNESCO during 1967-72 for equipment, faculty training and post-graduate programmes.
- This Institute was selected for Indo-UK REC Project (1994-99), primarily focused on enhancing the exposure of faculty in Design discipline through study and interaction visits.
- A lead institution under the World Bank funded Technical Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP) of Government of India (2003-2009), TEQIP-II phase (2010-2017) and TEQIP-III phase (on-going since 2017).



Powers and Functions of the BOG



- Shall be responsible for the general superintendence, direction and control of the affairs of the Institute.
- Shall exercise all the powers of the Institute not otherwise provided for by NIT Act, the Statutes and the Ordinances.
- Shall have the powers to review the acts of the Senate.
- The Board of the Institute shall:
 - Take decisions on questions of policy relating to the administration and working of the Institute
 - Institute Courses of study at the Institute
 - Make Statutes
 - Institute and appoint persons to academic as well as other posts in the Institute
 - Consider and modify or cancel Ordinances

Powers and Functions of the BOG

- Consider and pass resolutions on the annual report, the annual accounts and the budget estimates of the Institute for the next financial year as it thinks fit and submit them to the Council together with a statement of its development plans
- Exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be conferred or imposed upon it by NIT Act or the Statutes.
- The Board shall have the power to appoint such committees, as it considers necessary for the exercise of its powers and the performance of its duties under NIT Act.

Powers of the Finance Committee



- The Finance Committee shall have power to:
 - Examine and scrutinize the annual budget of the Institute prepared by the Director and make recommendations to the Board; and
 - Give its views and make its recommendations on any financial question affecting the Institute to the Board either on the initiative of the Board or of the Director, or on its own motion.

Building and Works Committee



- The Building and Works Committee of the Institute consists of the following members:
- (i) The Director; [ex- officio] Chairman
- (ii) One member nominated by the Central Government Member not below the rank of Director or Deputy Secretary;
- (iii) One member nominated by the Board of Governors; Member
- (iv) The Dean [Planning & Development] or similar position Member
- (v) One expert each from Civil and Electrical Engineering Wing of Central or State Government or any autonomous Members body of repute
- (vi) The Registrar [ex-officio] Member Secretary

Powers and Functions of the B&WC



- The Building and Works Committee shall,
 - Under the directions of the Board shall carry on construction of all major work after the necessary administrative approval and expenditure sanction from the Board;
 - Have the power to give the necessary administrative approval and expenditure sanction for minor works and works pertaining to repair and maintenance, within the approved budgetary provision of the Institute.
 - Cause to prepare estimates of cost of buildings and other capital works, minor works, repairs, maintenance and the like;
 - Be responsible for making technical scrutiny of the design, estimates and specifications of the material as may be considered necessary;

Powers and Functions of the B&WC



- Be responsible for enlistment of suitable contractors and acceptance of tenders and shall have the power to give direction for departmental works where necessary;
- Have the power to settle rates not covered by tender and settle claims and disputes with contractor;
- If in the opinion of the Chairman of the Building and Works Committee, any emergency has arisen which requires immediate action to be taken, he shall take such action and report the same to the Building and Works Committee and the Board at their next meeting.
- The Building and Works Committee shall also perform such function and exercise such powers as may be entrusted by the Board from time to time.
