Two copies of proposals complete in all aspects are to be submitted through proper channel to Project Coordinator, Design and Innovation Centre (DIC), Centre for Medical Diagnostic and Research - on or before 7 November, 2016. Instructions

The scheme is instituted for the purpose of providing assistance in the form of grants to

students for scientific and innovative research work.

The projects will be eligible for a minimum grant of Rs.30, 000/- and a maximum of Rs.50, 000/

The project team (batch) can have up to a maximum of five students and team can submit only

one proposal.

• It may be noted that the project proposed should be original, innovative, novel and should have

utility and applicability for implementation. Kindly note that the evaluation of the project is also based on

these factors.

The project will be forwarded through Project Mentors (Faculty) and respective Head of the

Department.

Project proposals received will be reviewed and evaluated and those selected will be notified in

the Institute website.

The sanctioned projects should be completed and the report should be submitted before end of

April 2017.

The mentors will be responsible for timely submission of final report and Utilization certificate.

Project proposals not in the prescribed format will not be considered.

Two copies of the proposal should be signed and forwarded by the mentor through HOD so as

to Project Coordinator (DIC), Centre for Medical Diagnostic and Research, MNNIT Allahabad, on or

before November 7, 2016. Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered.
