The Committee considered the proposal of DUGE of Electronics and Communication Engineering Department and Electrical Engineering Department for the replacement of the first year subjects on IEP by splitting the course EX101/201 as independent basic course of Electrical Engineering Department (EE101) and basic course on Electronics and Communication Engineering Department (EC201).
- The Committee considered the proposal of DUGC of Humanities and Social Sciences for allocating approval credit to CSW (H602). The matter was discussed and it was recommended that the course be allocated <u>one</u> credit.
