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The Senate extended warm welcome to the new Chairman, Senate and Director of the Institute, Prof. Parthasarathi Chakrabarti. The Chairman extended welcome to the members and thanked them for taking their time out to attend the meeting.

Agenda wise proceedings are as follows:

Item No. 36.01 : To confirm the minutes of the Thirty Fifth (35th) meeting of Senate

held on 31.03.2011.

Resolution : The Senate confirmed the minutes of its Thirty Fifth (35th) meeting held on 31.03.2011 as circulated with following modifications:

(i) Sl. No. of the resolution after Resolution No. 35.03 may be read as "Resolution No. 35.04" in place of "Resolution No. 35.05", which had appeared inadvertently.

Resolution

: With the permission of the Chairman, the Senate considered the following matters:

- The Senate considered the recommendations of the DPGC of the Department of Applied Mechanics for grant of extension of one semester (July 2011- December 2011) to Mr. Vishwa Ratna Mishra (2005RAM03) for submission of Ph.D. thesis, and resolved to grant extension of one semester for submission of Ph.D. thesis in principle, as his Ph.D. thesis is in final stage of checking as reported by the Supervisor.
- The Senate considered the recommendations of the DPGC of the Department of Chemistry for allowing a Project Fellow under UGC Major Research project of the department, Mr. Rohit Srivstava, having 59% marks in M.Sc., for admission to Ph.D. programme and resolved that as the eligibility for admission to Ph.D.

programme in the Institute is minimum 60% marks is Post graduate examination, therefore, his request can not be accepted.

(iii) The Senate considered the recommendations of DPGC of Department of Physics for sympathetic consideration for allowing Mr. Umesh Pratap Singh (2008RPH04), a part time Ph.D. student for continuing his research work to complete Ph.D. progremme. The Senate observed that he has got eleven Xs in his previous semesters and resolved to turn down his request, & his candidature be terminated.

- (iv) The Senate noted and ratified the decision of the Chairman, SPGC for termination of Ph.D. programme of Mr. Shiva Kumar (2009RME05), a Ph.D. student of this Department of Mechanical Engineering on the basis of his unsatisfactory performance and presentation in the Comprehensive Examination held on 11.05.2011, second time.
- (v) The Senate considered the recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Senate for suggesting the alternative of the Summer Semester as well as the decision of the Senate to scrap the Summer Semester in principle and resolved that the Summer Semester will not be in place from the next academic session. For alternatives of the Summer Semester and its implementation, the same Committee is requested to submit its recommendation by 30th June, 2011 to the Chairman, Senate for consideration. Chairman, SUGC will act as Convener of the Committee.
- (vi) The Senate noted that Prof. R.C. Mehta, and Prof. Triloki Nath, Senate members will be retiring from the services of the Institute on 30.06.2011 and appreciated the contributions made by them for the development of the Institutes, especially as a Senate Member.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
