III. The Senate considered the request of Mr. Ajay Kumar Meena (Registration 20082043) a B.Tech. student of the Department of Electrical Engineering for registration in 8th semester.

The Senate noted that as per records, Mr. Meena has not cleared his 2nd year and therefore he is allowed to register in 6th semester to clear his backpapers. Further, since the student had already registered himself and completed his 7th semester by hiding the facts, the Senate resolved that he may be allotted a separate project in the 8th semester, when he is allowed to register for 8th semester after clearing backlog of previous years.

IV. The Senate considered the request of Ms. Sneha Shukla (Registration No. 2010BM20) a student of M.Tech. (Biomedical Engineering), for leave for another one semester in continuation of leave of previous two continuous semesters; and noted that she has not yet submitted her medical fitness. The Senate resolved that, she may submit her request after submission of certificate of medical fitness.

Item No. 39.07

To consider the attendance requirement for PG programmes.

Resolution

The Senate considered the attendance requirement for Post Graduate programmes and noted that the Senate in its Fourteenth (14th) meeting held on 27.01.2006 has already decided to allow all the students to appear in the End Semester Examination whose attendance is 70% or more. The Senate also noted the following recommendations of the Joint Meeting of SUGC and SPGC held on 19.01.2006 which was also approved by the Senate in its Fourteenth (14th) meeting held on 27.01.2006:

- (i). Students with less than 75% attendance in a subject are not to be allowed to appear in the End Semester Examination of that subject. This implies that 25% shortage of attendance includes absence due to Sports/games activity, Campus interviews, Medical and any other type of leaves, etc.
- (ii). In addition, Chairman Senate in consultation with Dean (Academic), Chairman SUGC/SPGC may give a maximum relaxation of 5% below 75% requirements for special cases only. Such cases should be duly recommended by respective DUGC/DPGC with supporting documentation and proper justification for the same."

In view of above, the Senate resolved that the above resolution of the Senate for attendance requirements of all programmes may be adhered.

Item No. 39.08

Any other matter with permission of the Chair.

Resolution

With the permission of the Chairman, Senate, the Senate considered the following matters:

(i). Status of admission in M.S.W. & M.Sc. (Mathematics and Scientific Computing) programmes.

The Senate considered the data presented on the number of applications, number of students admitted as well as number of students passed out in the M.S.W. and M.Sc. (Mathematics and Scientific Computing) programmes; and resolved that a Committee may be constituted by the Chairman, Senate to propose the methodology to be adopted to attract good quality students to be admitted to these programmes. The recommendations of the Committee may be put up before the Senate in its next meeting for consideration.

(ii). Procedure and time frame for retention of records.

The Senate considered the matter concerning the procedure and time frame to be adopted for retention of academic records, such as evaluated answer scripts for various examinations, attendance registers as well as other academic records; and resolved that a Committee may be constituted by the Chairman, Senate to recommend the procedure and time frame to be adopted for retention of academic records. The recommendations of the Committee may be putup before the Senate in its next meeting.

(iii). Extension of one year to Mrs. Vijaya Bhadauria (2005REL04), Ph.D. scholar of department of Electronics and Communication Engineering to complete her Ph.D. programme.

The Senate considered the request made by Mrs. Vijaya Bhadauria (2005REL04) a Part-time Ph.D. student of the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering for extension of year to complete her Ph.D. programme; and resolved to grant her extension of one year effective from July 1, 2011 to complete her Ph.D. programme.

(iv). Extension of one semester to Mr. Y. K. Gupta (2004RCE06), Ph.D. scholar of department of Civil Engineering to complete his Ph.D. programme.

The Senate considered the request made by Mr. Y. K. Gupta (2004RCE06) for extension of one semester to complete his Ph.D. programme. The Senate noted that the Open Seminar of Mr. Y. K. Gupta was held on 14.07.2009 and the

stipulated time period of six years is over on 23rd July, 2010. Further, no time extension was sought on expiry of time period. The Senate also noted that in the request of Mr. Gupta, neither he has given any specific reasons for the same nor the supervisor has given his specific recommendations in this case. Further, the request is also not considered by the SPGC. The Senate resolved that the specific reasons from the student as well as the thesis supervisor be sought and then the same be considered by the SPGC in its meeting. The recommendations of SPGC be put up before the Senate / Chairman, Senate for consideration.

(v). Recommendation of DPGC of the Department of Physics to review the decision of the Senate for termination of Ph.D. programme of Mr. Umesh Pratap Singh (2008RPH04).

The Senate considered the recommendations of the DPGC of the Department of Physics to review the decision of the Senate for termination of Ph.D. programme of Mr. Umesh Pratap singh (2008RPH04) and noted that the recommendations of DPGC is not considered by the SPGC. The Senate resolved to refer the recommendations of DPGC to SPGC for consideration. The recommendations of SPGC on the matter be put up before the Senate in its next meeting.

(vi). Recommendations of DPGC of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering for inclusion of Dr. Prabhat Ranjan as Ph.D. Supervisor.

The Senate considered the recommendations of DPGC of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering for inclusion of Dr. Prabhat Ranjan, System-Manger as a Ph.D. supervisor of Ms. Puspha Kesarwani (2011RCS02). The Senate noted that as per section 11.1.3., "Thesis Supervisor (s) of a student will normally be appointed from amongst the faculty members at MNNIT Allahabad using modalities decided by the departments." In view of this, the Senate resolved that with the existing provisions, Dr. Prabhat, Ranjan, System Manager cannot be included as a Ph.D. supervisor of Ms. Puspha Kesarwani.

(vii). Request of Mr. Anil Kumar Sahu (Registration No.2010IS18) for grant of leave for 27.09.2011 to 30.10.2011.

The Senate considered the request of Mr. Anil Kumar Sahu (2010IS18) for grant of leave from 27.09.2011 to 30.10.2011 which is more than two weeks and resolved that details of his attendance during the semester may be put up to the Chairman Senate, for his consideration under provisions prescribed in the P.G. Manual.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks to the Chair.


