 - (a) The student will write a letter to Head of his department in consultation and agreement with present supervisor for inclusion of co-supervisor from outside the Institute clearly stating the reason for inclusion.
 - (b) The matter will be discussed in DPGC regarding need of co-supervisor from outside the Institute. If DPGC agrees then HOD will write a formal request letter to the proposed external co-supervisor asking to give his consent for supervising the thesis at MNNIT Allahabad along with his Bio-data with original signature at each page and NOC from his organization for guiding thesis at MNNIT Allahabad.
 - (c) Once above formalities are completed, the DPGC may recommend the case along with all original documents to SPGC for consideration and recommendation to Chairman Senate for approval.
- (ii) SI. No. 2: The Senate noted and ratified the approval accorded by the Chairman, Senate on the recommendations of the SPGC regarding conversion of Ph.D. programme from full-time to part-time of Mr. Ajay Kumar Tiwari [2008RPH03], a Ph.D. student of Department of Physics.
- (iii) SI. No. 3: The Senate noted and ratified the approval accorded by the Chairman, Senate on the recommendations of the SPGC regarding conversion of Ph.D. programme from full-time to part time of Mr. Mohan Chandra Mathpal [2010RPH52], a Ph.D. student of Department of Physics.

- (iv) SI. The recommendations of the Committee will be put up before the Senate / Chairman, Senate for consideration.
- [B] The Senate considered the letter received from MHRD regarding the decision on NIT Council regarding admission of students under the Ministry of External Affairs-Quota and ICCR-Quota through entrance examination and conduction of orientation course for the students admitted under ICCR quota, prior to the start of 4 years B.Tech. course for these students and accepted the same in principle.
 - The Senate further resolved that for formulating the procedure for the same, a committee may be constituted by the Chairman, Senate. The recommendations of the Committee will be put up before the Senate in its next meeting.
- [C] The Senate considered the proposal for running Part-time Ph.D. programme under TEQIP-II as per TEQIP-II guidelines and resolved to accept the same in principle. The Senate further noted that as per new ordinances for Doctoral programmes, no provision for Part-time Ph.D. pro gramme exists, except for faculty/sponsored project staff of MNNIT Allahabad, therefore, it was resolved that a proposal for amendment in ordinances for the same be put up in the next meeting of the Senate.
