6.01 : The Senate Confirmed the minutes of the Vth meeting of the Senate held on 13-12-2003 with the following observation .

i) In resolution No. 5.07 the following be added as this was left in typing.

"It was further resolved, that the Chairman, Senate is authorized to approve the recommendation of the Chairman, SPGC on the report of examiners and viva-voce of the candidates for award of the Ph.D. on behalf of the Senate and the same be reported in the next meeting of the Senate."

ii) The Senate reviewed the following clause of the Post –graduate Ordinances/Manual and it was decided that:-

Under clause (2) "Admissions" sub-clause 2.3.2 of MMS/ MBA, in resolution No. 5.02 Annexure-I" the following be added:-

The Senate approved the eligibility qualification for the admission in MMS for the Academic Year 2004-05 as "Bachelors Degree" in any discipline or its equivalent".

However, from the academic session 2005-06 and thereafter subclause 2.3.2 will read as follows:-

2.3.2 MMS/MBA-IBIT

"The candidates must have a Bachelors degree in Engineering / Technology /Science or equivalent degree with Maths/Economics as one of the Subjects."

iii) Under clause (7) "Academic requirements", Sub-clause (7.1) the Following be added.

in the Senate considered at length the preparation of the scheme of Evaluation and Course Structure for B.Tech. III to VIII Semester to be effective from the academic session 2004-05 as informed by Prof. B.D.Chadhaury the Chairman, SUGC,

It was decided, that the Chairman, Senate be authorized to constitute a Committee to review the Under Graduate academic programmes with the following terms of reference.

- The Committee is expected to undertake a thorough review of the course structure and contents, for all the eight semesters of the B.Tech. programmes, keeping in view the latest developments in Technology and growing importance of Basic Sciences and Social Sciences. The committee shall finalize its draft recommendations by April 15, 2004.
- The Chairman of the Committee is authorized to invite experts from industry, leading technical educational institutions and inputs from well established alumni professionals as and when required.
- In order to facilitate discussions institute-wide, the Chairman of the committee will organize a workshop in 3rd week of April 2004, for inputs from the Faculty. After incorporating the feedback available in the workshop the final proposal of the Curriculum shall be placed for Senate approval in early May,2004.
- 6.03: The Senate postponed the consideration with regards to the format of Degree Certificate for B.Tech., M,Tech., MCA, MMS, MBA(IBIT) and Ph.D. as recommendations of the Committee appointed by the Senate vide resolution No. 5.08 dated 13.12.2003 were yet to be received. The matter will be considered in the next meeting of the Senate.
- 6.04 The Senate considered and approved in principle the recommendations of the Committee appointed by the Senate vide resolution No. 5.09 dated 13.12.2003 with regard to the proposal for Sequential Summer Semester's programme for M.Tech in Computer Sc. & Engineering in the "Software Engineering" and "Communication Engineering" for M.Tech. in Electronics Engineering and "Water Management" in Civil Engineering and these courses may be started from the Academic Session 2004-2005.

It was decided to constitute a Committee of the following members to examine the scheme of evaluation and course structure of "Water Management" Programme.
