1. The minutes of 6th meeting of the Senate held on 12th March, 2004 & emergent meeting held on 12-4-2004 & 18-5-2004 were confirmed.

2. The Senate considered the report of the Institute Undergraduate Academic Programme Review Committee. The Senate decided to include Physical Education Comprising of NSS, NCC, Sports, Yoga, etc. activities as one of the subject with Zero credit during B.Tech. Second and third semester for all branches. This subject will have a weekly engagement of three hours beyond regular time table and will be coordinated by the Dean (Student Affairs) with assistance from the President, Student Activity Center. The grade will be awarded on the basis of attendance which must not be less than seventy five percent.

The Senate approved the report of the committee with above modification including curriculum structure and Courses. It was decided to make this new curriculum be effective from the batch admitted in the years 2004-05 and onward. Further, for the batch admitted in the Year 2003-04, the scheme would be applicable from third semester onward.

It was also decided that the Senate would be happy to consider suggestions and comments from faculty members, alumni and students on revised scheme.

- Senate approved the modified course structure of M.Tech. (Material Science & Engineering) as proposed by the DPGC of Applied Mechanics Department and recommended by the SPGC.
- 4. The format of the degrees as circulated in the earlier meeting were approved.
- 5. The cases of the deficient M.Tech. students were considered by the Senate and it was decided that no student who has a CPI of less than 5.6 would be permitted to continue in the programme.
- The Senate authorized the Chairman to take decision on applications from Ph.D.
 Students for exemption from course work.
- Request of Mr. Rajesh Tripathi, Reg. No. 1999CS19 M.Tech. Student of Computer Science Department (Teacher Candidate) for extension of the programme beyond the stipulated period was considered and approved with the condition

that he should register for his thesis during current semester (i.e. in July 2004)

Mr. Tripathi should finish his Programme this semester failing which his programme would stand terminated.

 The Senate authorized the Chairman to take decisions on case to case basis regarding application for transfer for Ph.D. registration from UPTU to this institute.

9. The Senate considered the course structure of MCA III and IV Semester. The structure and the syllabi as recommended by the DPGC and SPGC(Appendix B) are approved. The same are to be implemented for 2003-04 b. ch and onward batchs.

10. Senate considered the case of Mr. Manoj Kumar, M.Tech. Structural Engineering admitted in 2000-01. It was decided that Mr. Manoj Kumar should apply for leave for the period he was not present and should register in July 2004 and finish all the M.Tech. Programme requirements by the end of the Semester.
